

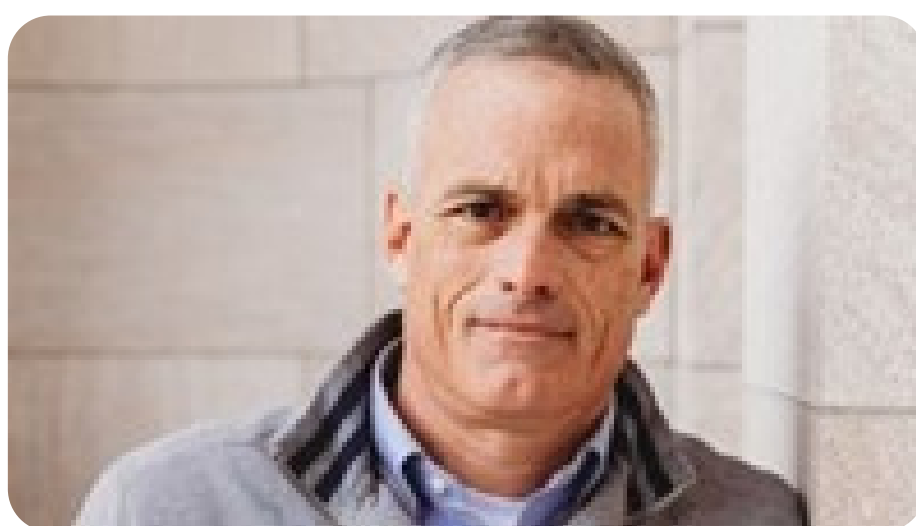

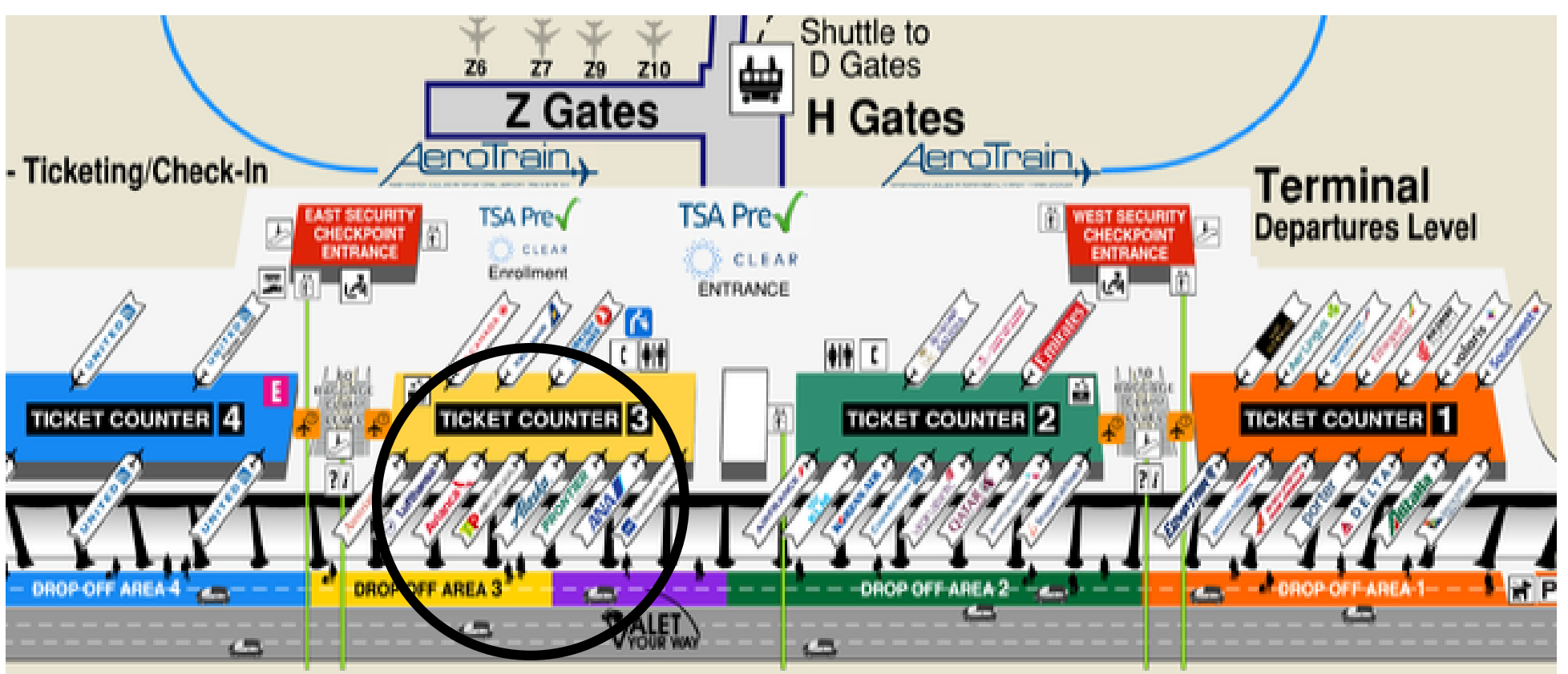

INBOUND FLIGHT

San Salvador, El Salvador to Washington Dulles (AV0584)

Monday, February 24, 2025

Depart: 9:20 AM

Arrive: 2:30 PM

Upon arrival in Washington Dulles Airport, missionaries will have their copies of their passports and their emergency contact information returned to them.

Luggage Guidelines

- Two (2) carry-on items: one (1) suitcase, plus one (1) personal bag (backpack, purse, shoulder bag, etc.)
- CBC will have one (1) checked bag for the group to carry larger toiletries: shampoo, lotion, etc.

NECESSITIES

- Passport & picture ID (Driver's license)
- Copy of passport & picture ID (Driver's license)
- Copy of front/back of any credit cards, medical card, immunization records
- Insect repellent
- Prescription medications
- Cell phone and charger - CBC is not liable for any damage, phone overage charges or theft to devices. Cell usage should be kept to a minimum during the mission trip week.
- Towel and washcloth for showering
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, lotion, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, hairbrush, comb, razor etc.) No curling irons or blow dryers please.
- Cash: \$100 (\$5, \$10, \$20 bills). US Dollars are the currency in El Salvador so there is no need to exchange money.
 - Will need \$12 cash to enter El Salvador.
 - There is a possibility the group may go out to dinner one evening. The estimated cost per person of a meal would be \$15-25

CLOTHING

- Enough for 5 days
 - You can wash and re-wear clothing. Washer & dryer available at mission site. Bring laundry soap or purchase detergent nearby.
- Men
 - Pants - travel, jeans, cargo
 - Shorts - cargo, basketball length style shorts
 - T-shirts/short sleeve shirts (no sleeveless)
 - Long sleeve shirts (rash guard, sun protection, quick dry)
 - Mass - pants & polo shirt (no shorts out of respect)
- Women
 - Pants - travel, jeans, cargo (no yoga pants)
 - Shorts - cargo, basketball length style shorts
 - T-shirts/short sleeve shirts (no sleeveless or tank)
 - Long sleeve shirts (rash guard, sun protection, quick dry)
 - Mass - slacks/skirt/dress (modest out of respect)
- Shoes
 - Comfortable shoes
 - Sturdy work shoes (no open-toed)
 - Sandals for evenings (optional)
 - Shower shoes (optional)
- Pajamas, robe, slippers, or flip flops
- Other
 - Hat for working in the sun, sunscreen, sunglasses
 - Jacket or sweatshirt and warm clothing for early mornings
 - Work gloves (leather is best), bandana
 - Rain jacket



ACCESSORIES

- Nalgene/similar water bottle (with screw-on top)
- Holder for passport/money, fanny pack, or backpack; travel pillow (optional)
- Prescribed medications
- As needed: pain medicine (aspirin, ibuprofen, Tylenol), motion sickness pills, anti-diarrhea (Imodium), antibiotics (Cipro), itch relief cream, band-aids, antibiotic cream (Neosporin), Pepto-bismol, Tums etc.
- Power bars, dried or dehydrated fruit, trail mix, nuts and seeds, snack crackers, beef jerky, something sweet for the evening team meeting (gummy bears, skittles, M&M's, etc.)
- Deck of playing cards, Uno, or other game for evening fellowship



Electronics

- Internet access (Wi-Fi) at mission is good
 - No phone use during group activities
 - Phones as cameras only during mission activities
 - Ask permission before you take someone's photo
 - **NO** photos taken of children at orphanage

- A visa is not required for stays under 90 days, but you must purchase a tourist card for 12 USD upon arrival. The card is valid for 90 days. Please make sure you have \$12 cash at the airport.
