## NECESSITIES

- Passport & picture ID
- Copy of passport & picture ID
- Copy of front/back of any credit cards, insurance card, immunization records
- Insect repellent
- Prescription medications
- Cell phone and charger - CBC is not liable for any damage, phone overage charges or theft to devices. Cell usage should be kept to a minimum during the mission trip week.
- Towel
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, lotion, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, hairbrush, comb, razor etc.) No curling irons or blow dryers please.
- Cash: May want some money changed into into Nuevo Sol (currency of Peru), can also bring cash to exchange at mission site, credit card (notify bank you will be traveling).
- Will need money for food in airport.

## CLOTHING

- Enough for 5-7 days (You can wash and re-wear clothing. Industrial washer & dryer available at mission site. Bring laundry detergent sheets.)
- Long pants
- T-shirts/short sleeve shirts (No tank tops or sleeveless shirts)
- Cargo or basketball length style shorts
- Long sleeve shirts
- Men - pants/polo shirt for Mass (no shorts); women– slacks/skirt/dress (no low cut blouses) for daily Mass; shoulders need to be covered
- Comfortable sneakers, sandals for evenings (optional), shower shoes
- Pajamas, robe, slippers, or flip flops it will be a bit cooler in the evening
- Hat for working in the sun, sunscreen, sunglasses
- Jacket or sweatshirt for evenings & early mornings
- Work gloves (leather is best), sturdy shoes, jeans or cargo pants (optional)



## ACCESSORIES

- Screw top reusable water bottle
- Holder for passport/money, fanny pack, or backpack; travel pillow (optional)
- Power converter and flashlight (optional)
- Mosquito netting for bed (optional)
- Power bars, dried or dehydrated fruit, trail mix, nuts and seeds, snack crackers, beef jerky, something sweet for the evening team meeting (gummy bears, skittles, etc.)
- Deck of playing cards, Uno, or other small game for evening fellowship

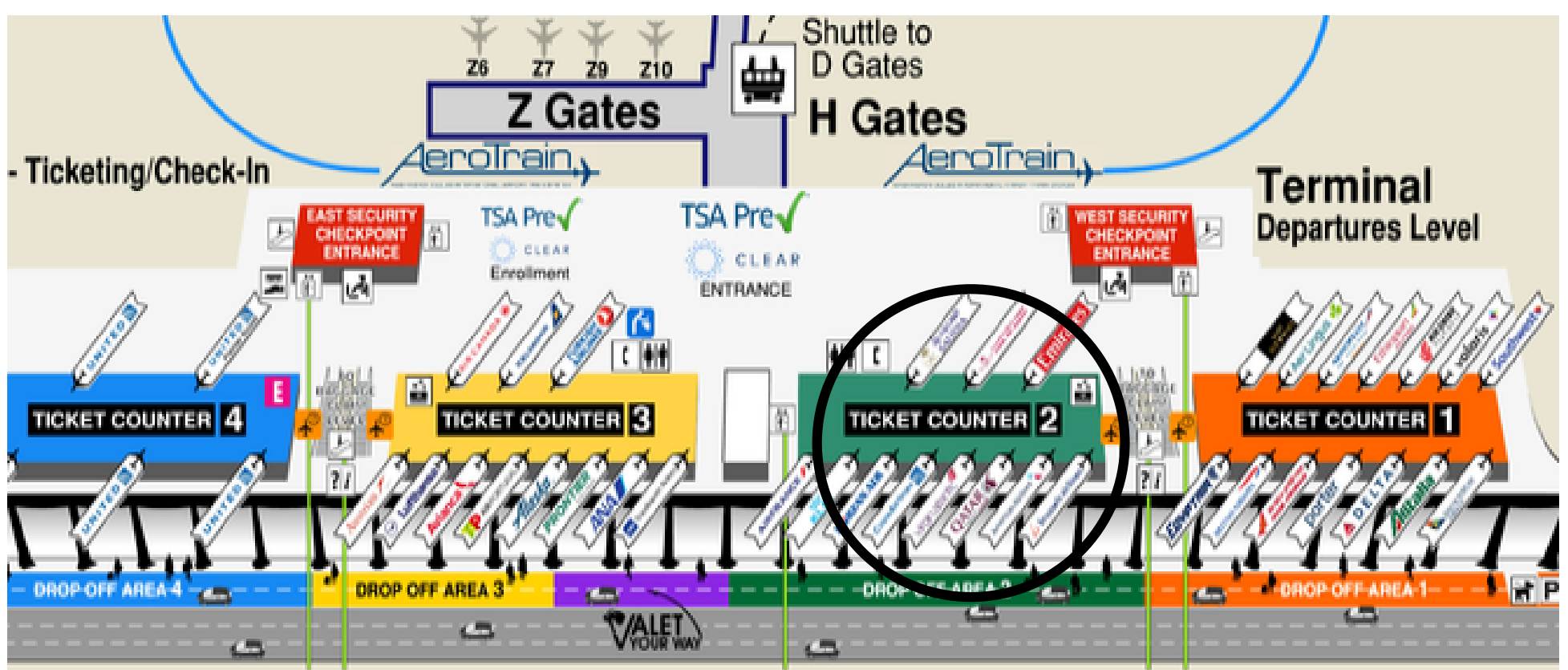

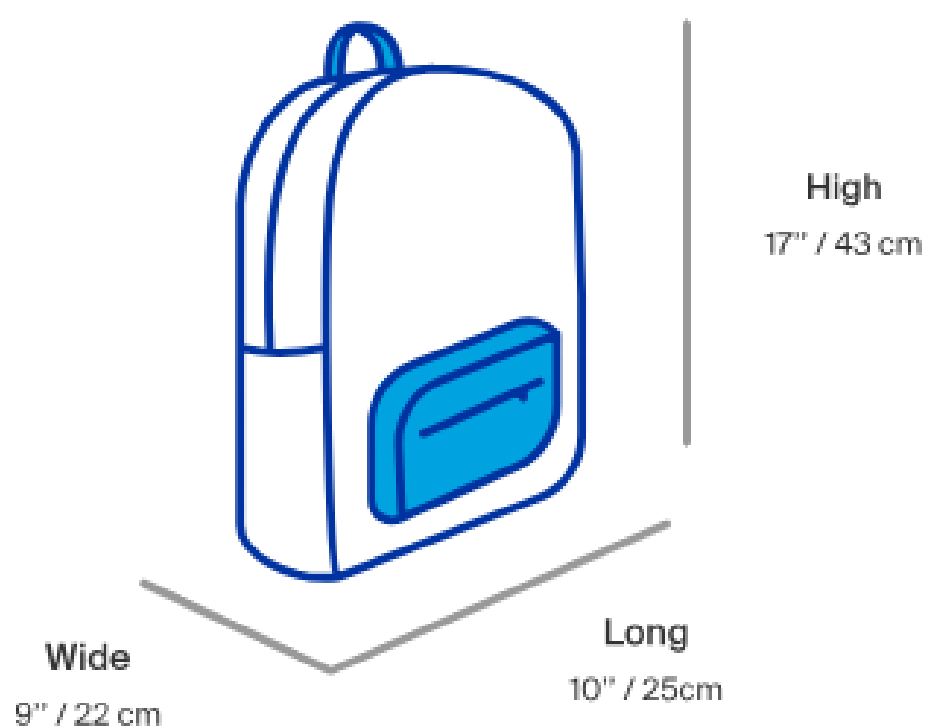

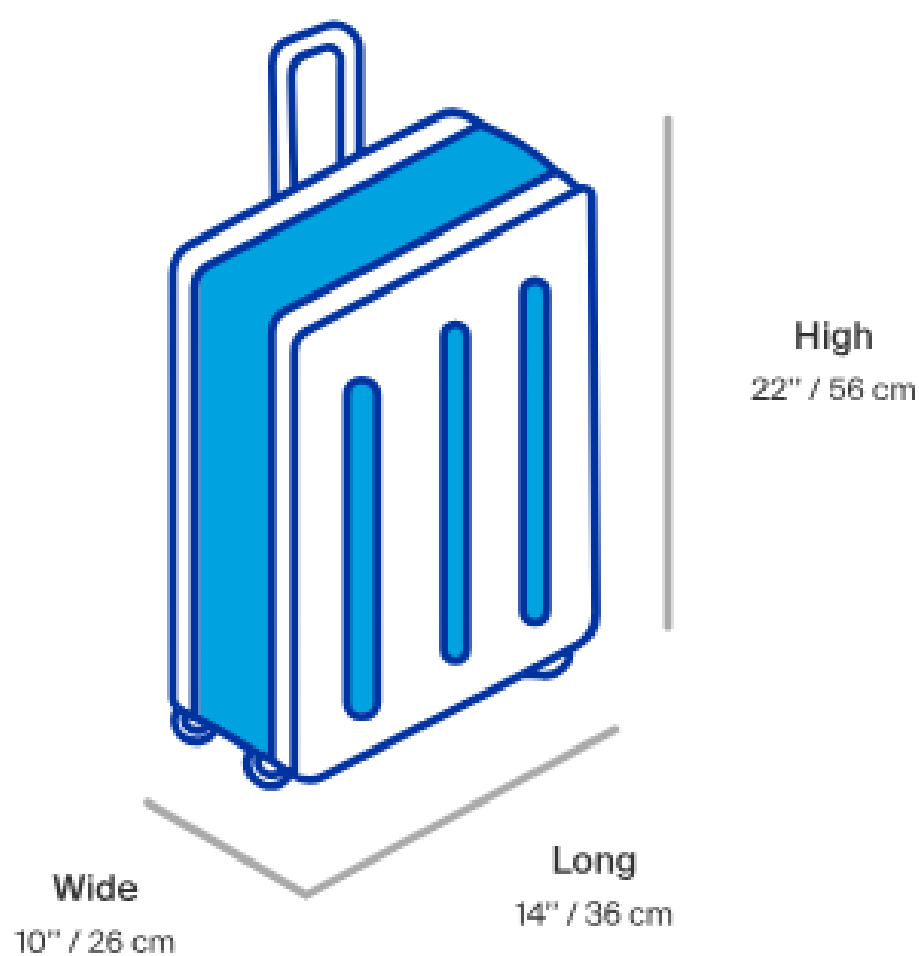
