TYPICAL DAY ON MISSION

- 7:30am - Morning prayer, grace and breakfast
- 8am - Collect personal belongings for the day; depart for mission site
- 9am - Depart for mission site
- 12pm - Return to Santisimo Sacramento Parish for lunch & siesta
- 2pm - Depart to mission sites for afternoon work
- 4pm - Return to Santisimo Sacramento Parish and clean up for Mass
- 6pm Mass
- 7pm Dinner, talk, evening reflection
- 9pm Free time
- 11pm Lights out

POTENTIAL PROJECTS

- Visit orphanage and play with young children & babies
- Deliver food bags to homes
- Teach English at the high school
- Build bamboo homes
- Buy fruits and vegetables at the market for girls' school
- Accompany and assist priest on pastoral visits
- Clothing distribution
- Prison ministry
- Serve meals to the needy
- Clear debris for beautification projects at schools



NECESSITIES

- Passport & picture ID (Driver's license)
- Copy of passport & picture ID (Driver's license)
- Copy of front/back of any credit cards, medical card
- Insect repellent
- Prescription medications
- Cell phone and charger - CBC is not liable for any damage, phone overage charges or theft to devices. Cell usage should be kept to a minimum during the mission trip week.
- Towel
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, lotion, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, hairbrush, comb, razor etc.) No curling irons or blow dryers please.
- Cash: (optional) \$100 converted into Nuevo Sol (currency of Peru), credit card (notify bank you will be traveling) *Ginet can change USD to Nuevo Sol at the parish when you arrive

CLOTHING

- Enough for 5-7 days
 - You can wash and re-wear clothing. Industrial washer & dryer available at mission site. Bring detergent sheets for washing.
- Men
 - Pants - travel, jeans, cargo
 - Shorts - cargo, basketball length style shorts
 - T-shirts/short sleeve shirts (no sleeveless)
 - Long sleeve shirts (rash guard, sun protection, quick dry)
 - Mass - pants & polo shirt (no shorts out of respect)
- Women
 - Pants - travel, jeans, cargo (no yoga pants)
 - Shorts - cargo, basketball length style shorts
 - T-shirts/short sleeve shirts (no sleeveless or tank)
 - Long sleeve shirts (rash guard, sun protection, quick dry)
 - Mass - slacks/skirt/dress (modest out of respect)
- Shoes
 - Comfortable shoes
 - Sturdy work shoes (no open-toed)
 - Sandals for evenings (optional)
 - Shower shoes (optional)
- Pajamas, robe, slippers, or flip flops
- Other
 - Hat for working in the sun, sunscreen, sunglasses
 - Jacket or sweatshirt and warm clothing for evenings & early mornings (65F)
 - Work gloves (leather is best), bandana



ACCESSORIES

- Reusable water bottle (with screw-on top)
- Holder for passport/money, fanny pack, or backpack; travel pillow (optional)
- Power converter and flashlight (optional)
- Mosquito netting for bed (optional)--many beds already have
- Prescribed medications
- As needed: pain medicine (aspirin, ibuprofen, Tylenol), motion sickness pills, anti-diarrhea (Imodium), antibiotics (Cipro), itch relief cream, band-aids, antibiotic cream (Neosporin), Pepto-bismol, Tums etc.
- Power bars, dried or dehydrated fruit, trail mix, nuts and seeds, snack crackers, beef jerky, something sweet for the evening team meeting (gummy bears, skittles, M&M's, etc.)
- Deck of playing cards, Uno, or other game for evening fellowship

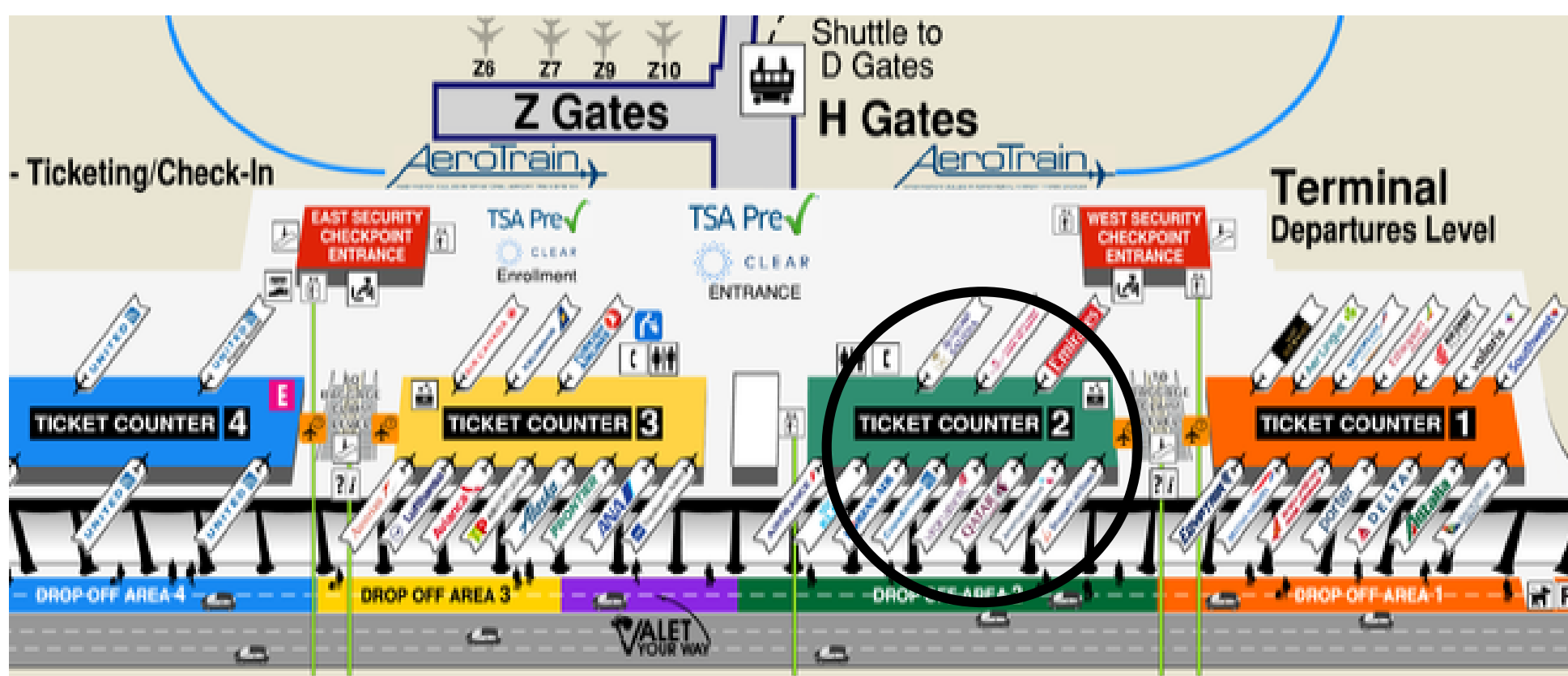

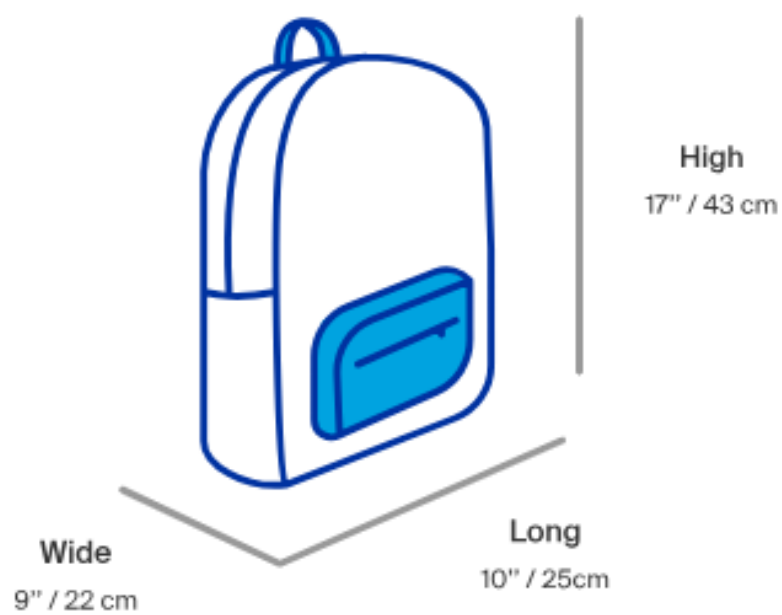

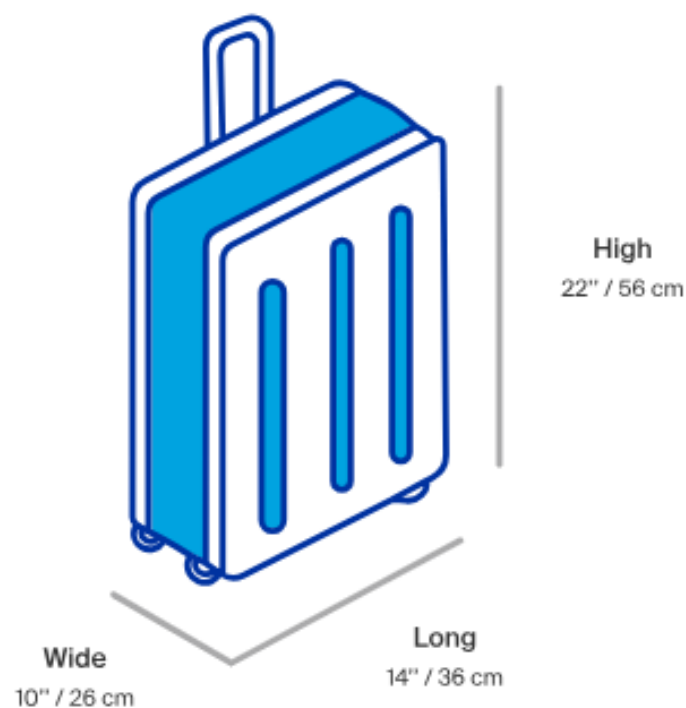

Carry-on only! You are allowed one small carry on and one personal bag or purse. Liquids & gels in a carry-on must be 3.4 ounces or less & placed in a single quart-size ziplock bag.
